***** This office is required by Election Law 9-208 4. (a) to have a manual hand count done. The manual hand count will start on Tuesday July 11th and will continue until all offices requiring a manual hand count have been completed. If any results change due to the manual recount we will amend the official results and post them on the web page.

Election Law 9-208 4. (a)

The board of elections or a bipartisan committee appointed by the board shall conduct a full manual recount of all ballots for a particular contest: . Where the margin of victory is twenty votes or less; or ii. Where the margin of victory is 0.5% or less; or iii. In a contest where one million or more ballots have been cast and the margin of victory is less than 5,000 votes. (b) For the purposes of this section, the term margin of victory shall mean the margin between all votes cast in the entire contest following the recanvass of votes.
